Admission Requirements for Applicants who Graduated from Foreign High Schools

Applicants who graduated from foreign high schools must present:

1. A. A Notarized photocopy of foreign high school diploma
 - B. A. Notarized translation into Hebrew**
 - C. Equivalent of matriculation certificate from the Israeli Ministry of Education**
– Department for evaluation of high school education 02-5601371/2
2. **Yael Test** (Hebrew test for new immigrants). Applicants with foreign high school diplomas are required to pass the Yael Test. This is a test of the linguistic level required for academic studies and applicants must achieve a **score of at least 100** (on a scale of 50-150). (This test is intended for those taking the Psychometric Entrance Exam **in a foreign language**. Exam dates and process of registration may be obtained from the National Institute for Testing and Evaluation 02-6759555
 - * Applicants who attended the preparatory program for new immigrants at Bar-Ilan University and completed the sixth level of the Hebrew articulation course – are exempt from the Yael Test.
3. **Psychometric score** as required by the relevant department (table attached).
SAT tests are an acceptable alternative to Psychometric Entrance Exams.
 - * **SAT I scores (2-part test - mathematical and verbal) should be divided in 2.**
(The maximal score on this test is 1600.)
 - * **SAT II scores (3-part test - mathematical, reading, and writing) should be divided in 3.**
(The maximal score on this test is 2400.)
4. **Preparatory courses will be required as necessary and as determined by the head of department.**
